CT ABDOMEN

HISTORY: History of pseudomyxoma peritonei. CA 19.9 now elevated. ?recurrence.

COMPARISON: CT of December 15, 2010.

TECHNIQUE: IV and oral contrast enhanced CT abdomen and pelvis.

FINDINGS:

There has been no significant change since the previous examination.

Mild biliary duct dilatation is likely related to the post cholecystectomy state. There is mild fullness to the renal collecting systems bilaterally with no frank hydronephrosis. The liver, spleen, pancreas, adrenal glands are normal. No significant intra-abdominal lymphadenopathy is identified. There is no free abdominal or pelvic fluid. There is again evidence of previous hysterectomy and partial cystectomy. Bowel anastomotic sites are unremarkable.

A tiny subpleural density in the right lung base (image 21) likely represents a tiny focus of atelectasis. The lung bases are otherwise clear.

No aggressive bone lesion is identified.

INTERPRETATION:

There is no evidence of recurrent or metastatic disease.
